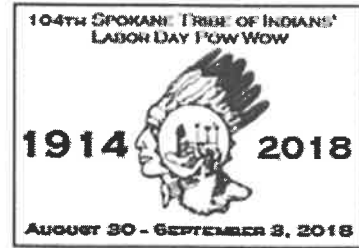

### Terms and Conditions

We are currently re-vamping our Vendor Process. We are limiting the amount of vendors into this year's pow wow to **only** those spots we have available. We will not allow other non-registered traders to pull in and set-up (This created a HUGE headache last year, and we are not going through **that** experience again!) The pow wow committee has also voted to ban walk around sales and raffles... It is only fair, you guys are paying the fees to vend... why should they be allowed to sell for free?

The fee for this year's event will be based on your stand size and power needs. If you can fit everything you will be selling in a 12'x12' space, your fee will be \$150 for the weekend (non-powered) or \$250 (powered,) if you need the larger 12'x24' size, your fee will be \$250 for the weekend (non-powered,) or \$350 (powered.) **An initial payment of at least ½ down will be due at the time of check in.** It is the duty of the Vendor to have their remaining balance **paid in full no later than 12:00pm on Sunday September 2, 2018.**

All payments must be made in either cash, cashier's check, bank draft or money order (*no personal checks will be accepted.*) Checks, drafts or money orders are to be made payable to: **Spokane Tribe of Indians.**

By August 1, the Vendor Coordinator should have made all slot selections, and will contact you to determine check-in times. Vendor spots will be marked prior to arrival and clearly marked to the size selected. **Please** make sure you stay within those dimensions. (Any vendor exceeding their allotted space may be charged an additional \$100 for the weekend.)

Each powered stand will have access to at least 1 20-watt outlet (per 12'x12' space,) any additional use of the Pow Wow's power that exceeds those limitations could lead to removal from the event. Any extension cords used must be heavy duty construction grade.

Arts and Crafts Vendors are to sell Arts and Crafts **only**. No sale of food, or drinks will be permitted. Absolutely no sales of tobacco products, e-cigarettes, toy or candy cigarettes, lasers, toy guns, knives or tomahawks of any kind will be tolerated. Silly string, silly putty and sticky hands are not allowed due to concerns it may damage dance regalia. Knives and cigarette lighters are permitted, but may not be sold to minors. If any item on sale is deemed objectionable by the Pow Wow Committee, you will be asked to remove the said item. Failure to remove the item, or setting it out again for sale could lead to your removal from the grounds. Camping and parking directly adjacent to your vendor space cannot be guaranteed.

*Spokane Tribal Members may qualify for a 50% vendor fee discount (pending enrollment verification.)* The Spokane Tribal Labor Pow Wow Committee is not responsible for lost, stolen or vandalized property.
